AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 15 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED “POLICE DEPARTMENT” SPECIFICALLY SECTION 18 THEREOF ENTITLED “OUTSIDE WORK”.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15 of the Township Code entitled “Police Department” and specifically the following provisions of Section 18 thereof “Outside Work” is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:

- C. All persons or entitles shall be required to make payments for outside work assignments payable to the Township of Barnegat, or contractually assigned outside work Police Administrator. All persons or entities shall be required to make payment within the same pay period. The outside work police office rate shall be as established in the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the applicable police union and the Township in place at the time the outside work request is made. All payments and fees required under the applicable Collective Bargaining Agreement shall be paid by the person or entity requesting the outside work assignment.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT, IN
THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING
ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE COST OF THE
CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW TOWN HALL AND
APPROPRIATING \$1,500,000 THEREFOR FROM THE
TOWNSHIP'S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The total amount of \$1,500,000 is hereby appropriated by the Township of Barnegat, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey (the "Township") from the Township's Capital Improvement Fund to provide additional funding for a portion of the cost of the construction of a New Town Hall, including all things necessary therefore or incidental thereto.

Section 2. The capital budget or temporary capital budget, as applicable, of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget, as applicable, and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Township Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey that Chapter 15 of the Township Code entitled "Police Department" and specifically subsection 9 thereof entitled "Rules and Regulations" is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15-9 of the Township Code hereby amended to read as follows:

There is hereby adopted Rules and Regulations pertaining to personnel and procedures of the Barnegat Township Police Department. The revised Rules and Regulations are on file in the Office of the Township Clerk and in the Office of the Police Department. Said Rules and Regulations shall be kept on file in the Office of the Township Clerk and shall be available for inspection by all members of the public during normal business hours.

SECTION 2. The below sections contained within the Rules and Regulations of the Police Department are hereby amended to read as follows:

2:4.1 Rank Established – Rank in the Police Department of the Township of Barnegat has established by Township ordinance shall descend in the following order:

- (a) Chief of Police;
- (b) Captain of Police;
- (c) Lieutenant of Police;
- (d) Sergeant of Police;

- (e) Detective First Grade;
- (f) Detective; and
- (g) Patrolman.

2:4-5 Detective – A title commensurate with certain investigative positions and assignments within the agency. The title of Detective shall occupy the same positional hierarchy as the position of Patrolman. An employee shall be designated a Detective at the discretion and direction of the Chief of Police. The designation shall be revocable at the discretion of the Chief of Police.

We are pleased to submit the following Scope of Work for Engineering Services to complete the designed improvements at Barnegat's existing water tower on Lakeland Drive.

Compensation and reimbursable expenses for the General Consulting Engineering Services to be performed shall be in accordance with the standard hourly rate schedule previously submitted to the Township as part of the Proposal for 2022, Township & Water/Sewer Utility Engineer Pool dated March 18, 2022.

PROJECT SCOPE

The basic work will include design of a 300' extension of 12" water main along the existing tower service road to connect between and existing water tower and the 12" main on Lakeland Drive. It is the intent of the Township, in order to expedite the completion of construction, to purchase through the State CO-OP Program all water main interconnect materials. The project will be bid with a requirement for contractor to complete installation and have system operational within 30 days of award.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

- I. Construction Document Bid Ready Phase Services - \$20,550 – ALAIMO GROUP will meet with the Township and complete set of construction documents consisting of drawings, specifications and engineers estimate.

- Consulting Engineers -

Civil • Structural • Mechanical • Electrical • Environmental • Planners

2. Advertising and Bidding Phase Services - \$1,580 - ALAIMO GROUP will assist the Township in obtaining and evaluating bids, attend a pre-bid meeting and will prepare addenda to the documents as necessary to answer Bidders' questions.
3. Full-Time Construction Phase Services - \$21,800 - ALAIMO GROUP will provide Full-Time Construction Administration Phase services; while we will not assume construction management responsibilities that are normally Contractor duties, we propose to provide the following services:
 - a. Monitor the progress of the work.
 - b. Hold progress meetings and prepare minutes.
 - c. Review of shop drawing submittals.
 - d. Response to RFIs (Contractor Requests for Information).
 - e. Full time observation, including tap, testing and disinfection, road restoration.
 - f. Alaimo would observe and review testing and disinfection results and provide Township with review and Authorization to Activate the new main.
 - g. Review contractor supplied as-built plans, in CADD and GIS.
 - h. Maintain construction reports.
 - i. Review and sign-off of Contractor applications for payment.
 - j. Review and processing of change order requests as applicable.
 - k. Inspection and preparation of supplemental deficiencies lists at substantial completion of the work.
 - l. Closeout project.
 - m. Monitor remedial construction work product during the one (1) year maintenance bond term.
4. Addition Services if Required - \$4,000 - ALAIMO "for the lump sum fee stated and if necessary, post construction, shall perform necessary field work and prepare plan/Metes and Bounds description for potential utility easement, for the newly installed water main". Until we know the as-built location provided by the contractor, we will not start easement plan. The Township will provide record survey of the existing water tower lot.

OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

1. The Owner will provide all necessary information regarding project scheduling, materials list of items purchased and made available to the successful low bidder, as-built plans for use and inclusion in the final plans and specifications and during construction.
2. The Owner shall be responsible for all costs associated with testing and investigative probes, to be performed by independent contractors or consultants.
3. The Owner shall be responsible for all costs associated with testing, remediation, disposal, etc. and/or special consulting services required for proper removal and disposal of any asbestos and/or other hazardous material encountered as part of this project.
4. The Owner shall be responsible for any permit and approval fees if required. Based on the current scope of the project it does not appear that NJDEP, Pinelands or OCSCD permits will be required.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

We anticipate that the Final Bid ready Construction Documents will be completed by the Alaimo Group two (2) weeks after verbal authorization by the Township.
